Individually sealed bids will be received from qualified vendors by Grant Soil and Water Conservation District (hereinafter called DISTRICT), at 721 South Canyon Boulevard, John Day, Oregon 97845 until 3:00 PM PDT, August 29, 2025 for the construction of approximately 5.5 miles of wire fence, in Grant County, Oregon. Immediately thereafter, Bids will be publicly opened. The Project location is approximately 7 miles southeast of Long Creek, Oregon. All work associated with this Invitation To Bid must be completed by August 1, 2026. Liquidated damages of \$100 per day will apply to the contract resulting from this Invitation To Bid, upon the contractor's failure to complete the work within the specified time.

PERSPECTIVE BIDDERS **ARE REQUIRED** TO BE LICENSED WITH THE STATE OF OREGON CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTORS BOARD (CCB)

This Invitation to Bid and the resulting Contract are subject to the provisions of the Federal Davis-Bacon Act (40 U.S.C. 3141 et seq.).

A voluntary pre-bid conference and tour of the work area will be conducted **August 20, 2025 at 9:00 AM (PDT**). The tour will initiate at Keeney Meadows, specifically at the intersection of Forest Service Roads 3945 and 3940.

Bidders are not required to attend this voluntary pre-bid conference and tour, but with the complexity of this project it is strongly recommended that bidders or their representatives attend.

Due to the popularity of powered fencing staple guns and the variety of models, **the District will not provide staples**. Bidders are requested to incorporate this cost into their bids; staples must meet the specified criteria.

Individually sealed envelopes or packages containing bids and supporting data as stipulated in the instructions to Bidders shall be clearly marked with the vendor's name and the fence project name, **JONES SF LONG CREEK FENCE PROJECT**. Bids sent by mail should be forwarded by certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed to the DISTRICT as shown above, in care of Pat Holliday, and likewise shall be clearly marked or endorsed as stated herein.

Bids received after the time established for receipt of bids will not be considered. Bids may be withdrawn or modified in writing at any time prior to bid opening, following the guidelines established in the Invitation to Bid.

The DISTRICT may reject any Bid not in compliance with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements and reserves the right to reject for good cause any or all Bids in whole or in part upon the finding of the DISTRICT that it is in the public interest to do so, to waive irregularities not affecting substantial rights, and to postpone the award of the work as

necessary for a period of time not to extend beyond thirty (30) days from the Bid Opening Date. Bid prices quoted shall remain firm for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of Bid Opening.

The apparent successful Bidder shall provide all required proofs of insurance, furnish all applicable security bonds, and other specified deliverables to the DISTRICT within twelve (12) calendar days from date the Intent-to-Award Announcement is issued by the DISTRICT. Failure to present the required documents within this period may result in Bid rejection.
