

The Walla Walla Public Library Is Moving! Thanks to incredible support from our community and generous donors, the Walla Walla Public Library at 238 E. Alder Street will be undergoing a full-building renovation beginning the week of June 8, 2026. In preparation for the estimated year-long construction project, the Walla Walla Public Library is moving all services to a temporary location at 115 W. Main Street in Walla Walla, right next door to the Washington Federal Bank and across the street from the Farmers Market shelter and Valley Transit Transfer Center.

Surplus library furniture and fixtures will also be for sale during the party. All purchased items must be removed from the premises at time of sale or no later than 3:00 pm, June 6, 2026.
