Since 2023, Baker City Downtown's two years stewarding Festival of Trees, over \$100,000 were raised to support forty five local projects. The proceeds from the event were distributed among the grantees at the discretion of the Community Grants Committee. Baker City Downtown will accept Grant Applications for the Festival of Trees Community Grant 2026 from July 31 - September 1, 2026. The Grants Committee will select this year's grantees by October 4. Preliminary grant amounts will be announced then. Final amounts granted will be determined once Festival of Trees Gala & Auction has concluded on December 4, 2026.

If selected, each grantee is expected to attend the Family Day on Saturday, December 5th, to host a game or entertainment activity for the public to enjoy throughout the day. Baker City Downtown will help coordinate these activities with each grantee once selections are made.
