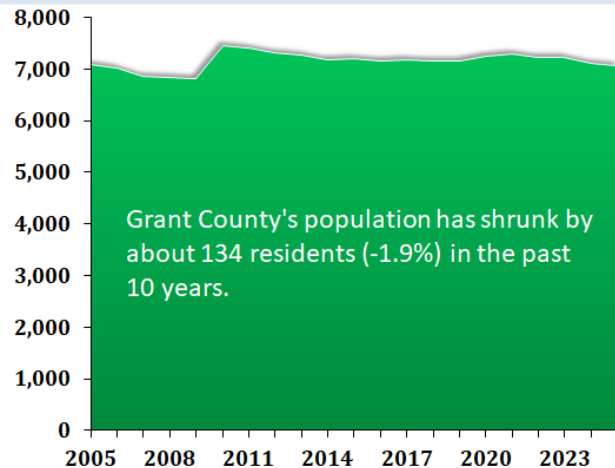

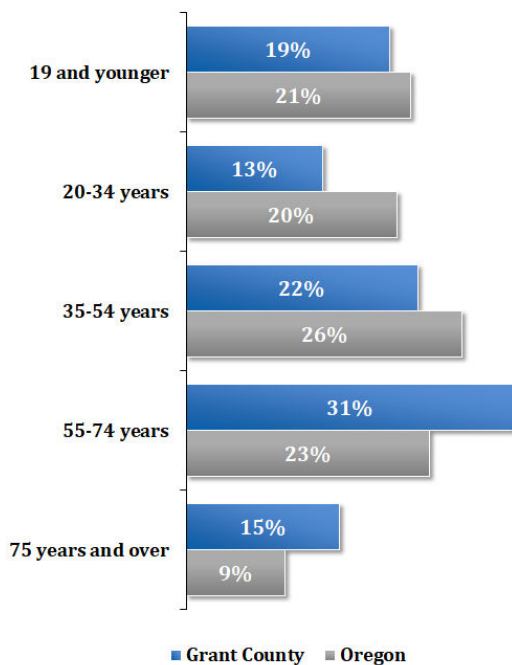

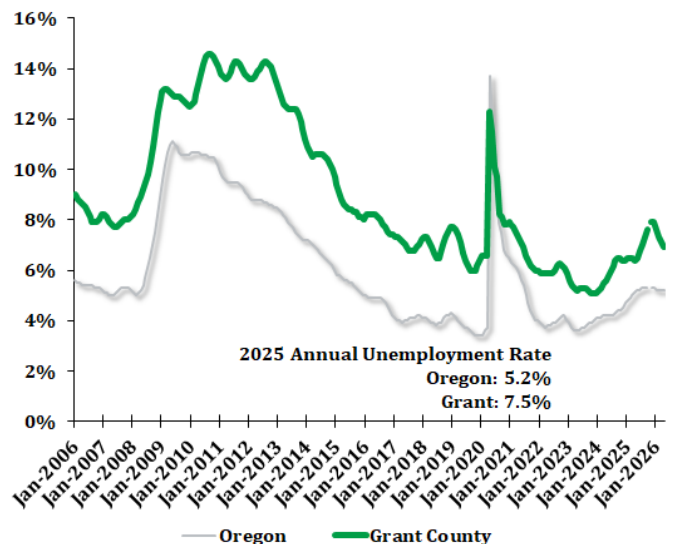
CHANGE IN POPULATION (2005-2025)



POPULATION BY AGE (2025)

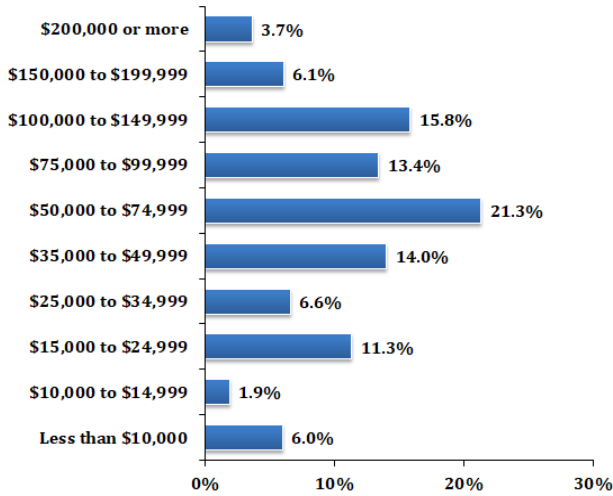


UNEMPLOYMENT RATE (SEASONALLY ADJUSTED)



HOUSEHOLD INCOME

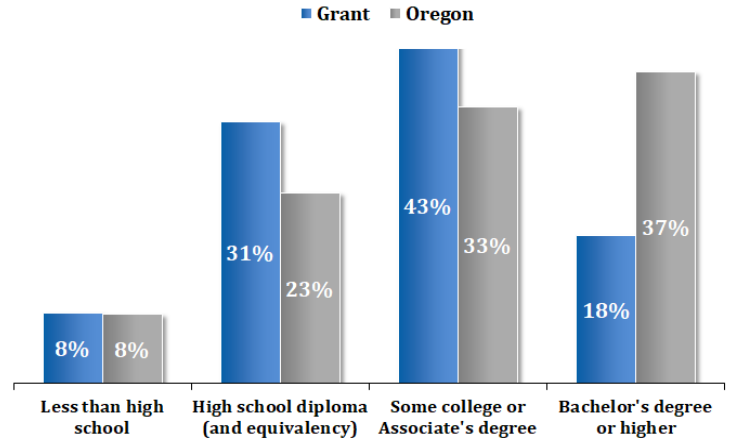

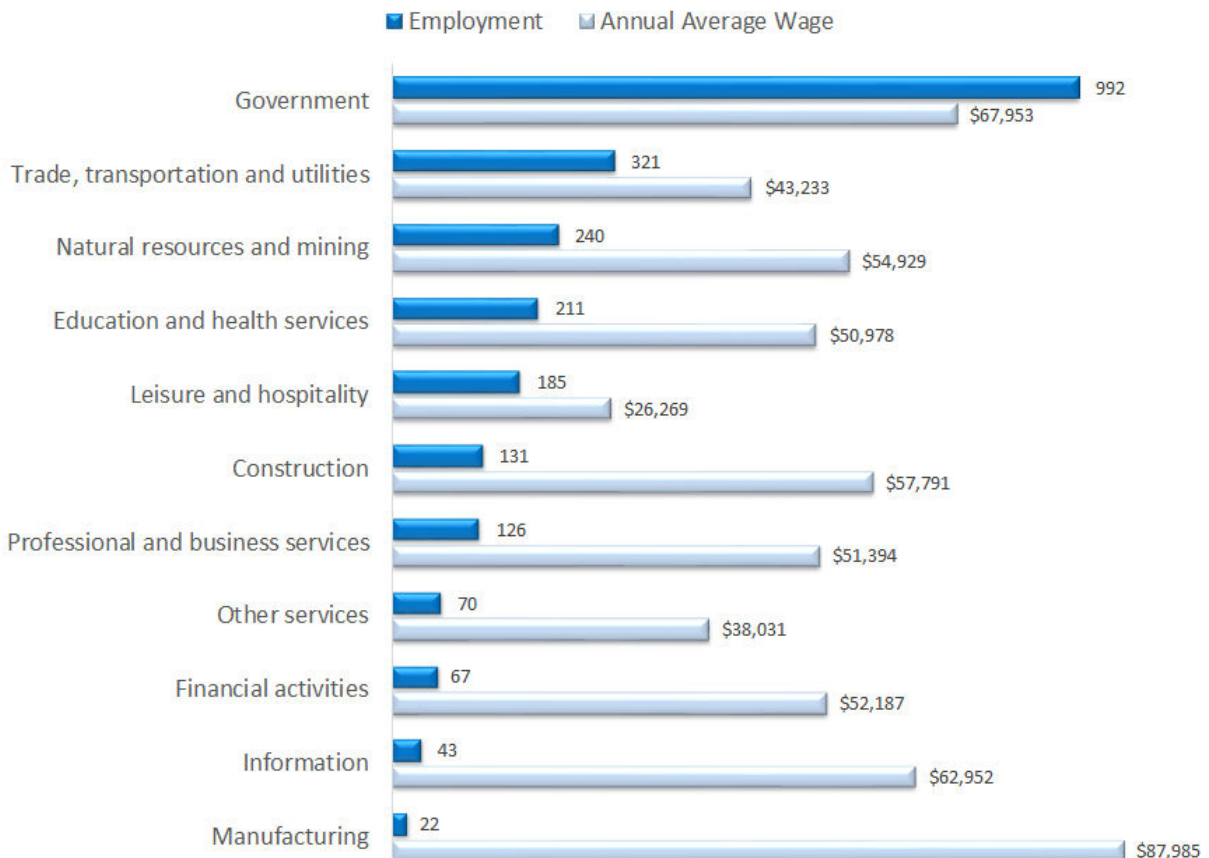
EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT
